

# DECK EQUIPMENT AND LAYOUT

## **DECK EQUIPMENT**

All exterior wood in teak
Grab rails at companionway
Teak handrails
Bow anchor roller
Self-draining anchor locker
Stainless bow pulpit with nav. lights
Stern pulpit with boarding gate & light
Stainless steel and teak swim ladder
Double lifelines
Aluminum toe rail
4 mooring cleats
Stainless steel chalnplates
Non-skid deck surface

3 winch handles 2 opening hatches on deck Main sheet traveller

2 x 2 speed self tailing genoa sheet winches

2 x halyard winches

I reefing winch on mast 2 double halyard lead blocks w/stoppers

2 inboard genoa tracks with cars

2 single turning blocks

Masthead light and steaming light

4 cleats in cockpit

2. aluminum clam cleats on roof

Aluminum deck filler caps · water, fuel and waste Plexiglass sliding companionway hatch & boards 2 aluminum chocks (stern)

Anodized double spreader mast Anodized boom with internal reefing 1 x 19 stainless steel rigging Stainless steel turnbuckles Back stay adjuster Boomvang Mainsheel Jib sheets Kevlar main & genoa halyards Topping lift Internal reef lines

#### SAILS

Teak cabin sole with dust catcher

Settee (convertible to single berth) Storage lockers under settee and water tank (50 gal.) Storage shelf outboard

L-shaped settee convertible to optional double berth Drop leaf dining table with bottle storage Storage shelf outboard of settee

#### NAVIGATION STATION

Chart table with storage Storage locker and bookshelf Electric panel with circuit breakers 12v and 110v installation Reading and chart light 2 drawers and pencil organizer

3 burner gimballed stainless steel stove w/oven (propane)
Large ice box with racks
Double stainless steel sink w/pressure water
Dish draining compartment
3 storage drawers w/ventilated bins
Fresh water pump
Hot water system
